All candidates must ensure that they meet the eligibility criteria and possess all necessary documents as mentioned in DTE Admission Information Brochure for MBA 2011-12.

Highlights Of Admission Procedure

01. Candidates have to apply to Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Mumbai

a) CET, GD & PI for Management

02. Candidates apply to Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), Mumbai with preferences of institutes as options.

03. Institute wise allotment list is sent to the respective colleges by DTE.

04. Candidates from allotment list of DTE report to the Institute for admission.

05. Institute level seats are advertised and applications are received.

06. GD & PI are conducted for institute level seats as applicable.
07. Based on merit and reporting admissions are done.
08. After DTE allotment rounds, vacant seats (if any) are advertised.
09. Merit list is displayed and based on reporting admissions are granted.
10. All documents are submitted for verifications to DTE / Pravesh Niyantaran Samiti (PNS) Mumbai.
11. Interim fees for courses as fixed by Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Mumbai.
12. In case the final approved by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti is less than the Interim Fee collected, we undertake to refund the difference amount to the student within four weeks declaration of the Fee on the official website of the Shikshan Shulka Samiti. However, if the Final Fee approved by the Shikshan Shulka Samiti is more than the Interim Fee collected, then the same shall be paid by the student / parent. An undertaking to this effect is to be given by the student and parent at the time of taking admission.
13. Candidates give an undertaking on Rs. 100/- stamp paper to pay revised fee as decided by Shikshan Shulka Samiti, Mumbai.
14. After scrutiny of each student's documents by DTE / PNS approval to admissions are granted. To avoid loss of admission or eligibility at late stage, students must contact / refer to Directorate of Technical Education (DTE), their regional offices or information brochure at DTE, website, www.dte.org.in for eligibility and procedural guidelines before applying for admissions.

MISCELLANEOUS

- The medium of instruction for degree course in Management is English.
- Admission of candidate who has been admitted to any course at college will be treated as finally confirmed only on producing of the Eligibility Certificate from the University to which the college is affiliated.
- Director of the institution at his or her discretion may refer any candidate to the appropriate medical authority for ascertaining the physical fitness of the candidate to undergo the requirements of the course. The report of medical authority shall be submitted to the Regional Head of Technical Education for further necessary action.
- It is to be noted that physically handicapped candidates are not provided with any additional facilities as far as the academic activities pertaining to the course are concerned.
- Director of the institution may verify the antecedents of any candidate through the appropriate police authority. The report received from police authority shall be submitted to the Regional Head of Technical Education for further necessary action.
- If any of the statement made in application form or any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his or her admission is later on at any time, found to be false or incorrect, his or her admission will be cancelled, fees forfeited and he or she may be expelled from the college by the Director. An appeal against the order of expulsion, however, may be preferred within 7 days to the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai, whose decision in such cases will be final.

RULES & REGULATION...

- **ATTENDANCE**

The Students are required to maintain a minimum of 90% attendance per semester. Any student failing to meet the above standard is liable to get his / her term canceled; in addition he / she will not be allowed to participate in the Campus Recruitment Program. Feedback based on monthly monitoring of attendance helps students maintain the minimum required attendance. The course is strenuous in nature and demands attendance on Sundays too. As such any student willing to put in long hours on a regular basis will be best suited to adapt to the course and derive maximum benefit from it.

- **DRESS CODE**

At RIBM, we believe in inculcating a sense of discipline among the students by strictly observing a dress code. Students are expected to wear formal dress (Shirt and Trousers with Tie for Gents; Salwar Kameez or Formals for Ladies) throughout the week, except on Saturdays which will be observed as informal dress day'. On the occasion of guest lectures, seminars, etc. students are expected to be dressed in the RIBM uniform (Blazers, Tie, Shirt, and Trouser for Gents and Formals for Ladies). A student failing to adhere to the dress code will not be allowed to attend the lectures and will face disciplinary action.

- **HOSTEL RULES**

The Boys and Girls Hostels at RIBM have a set of rules which have to be adhered to strictly by the students. Each hostel is headed by a warden who acts as a facilitator and observer to maintain the discipline in the hostels and ensure its smooth functioning. Students opting to stay in the hostel will have to sign an undertaking in accepting the rules, laid down by the management. Ragging of any type will not be accepted and the concerned student's admission would be cancelled immediately.

- **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE**

i) Notwithstanding anything contained in these Rules, if the Government takes any Policy decision pertaining to F.Y. admission, then the same shall be implemented immediately at that point of time as per the directives from the Government from time to time.

ii) The students while studying in this college, if found indulging in anti-national activities contrary to the provisions of Act and Laws enforced by Government or in any activity contrary to rules of discipline, will be liable to be expelled from the college without any notice by the Director of the college.

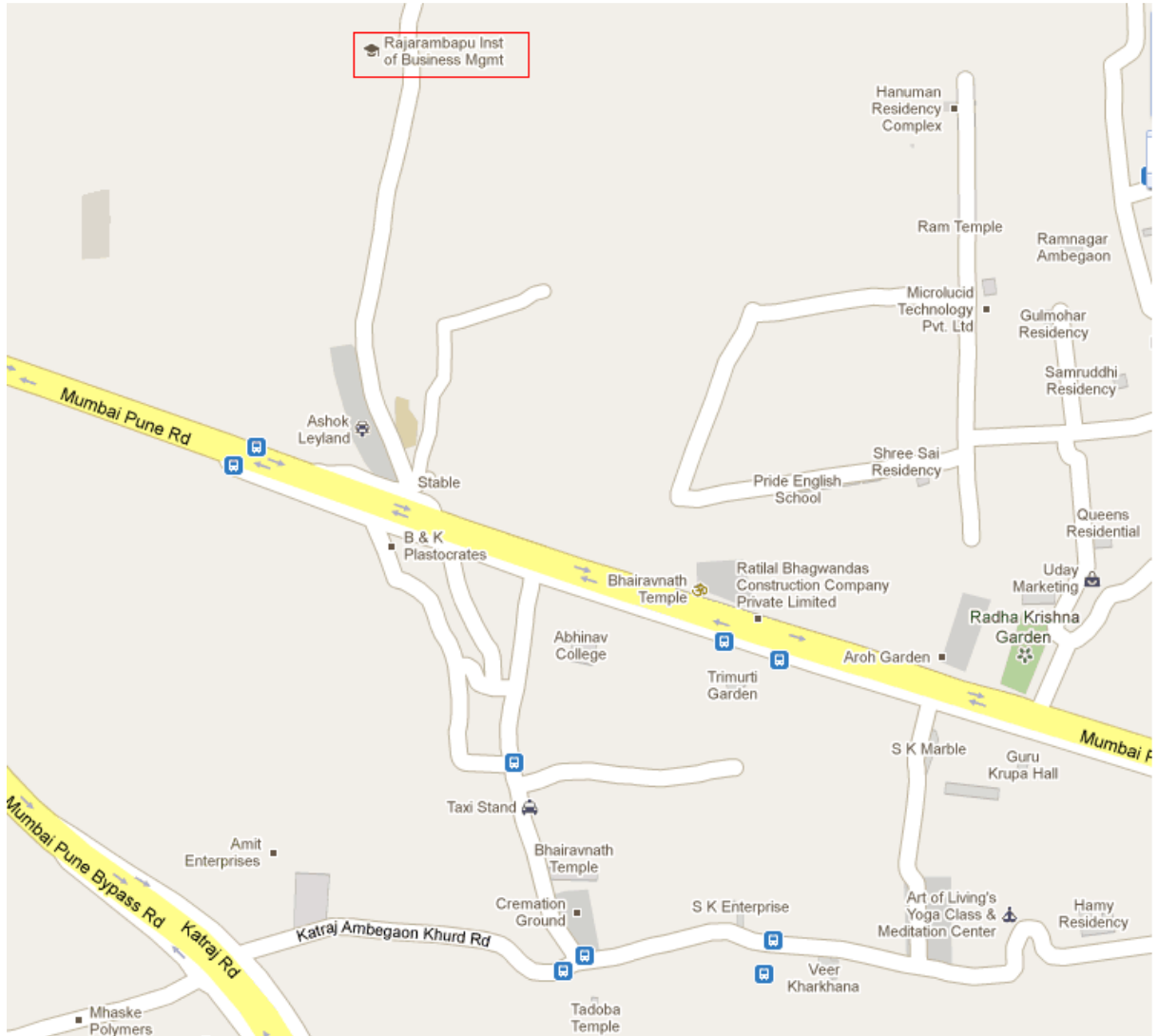
